Dr William Crotch (1775-1847) Figures by a Path in Hyde Park, London

Signed with initials verso: Hyde Park/Augt 8 1810/Wm J Habilla/He was going to school/next morning/WC Watercolour over pencil 8.4 by 16.3 cm., 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ by 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ in.

In early 1805, Crotch resigned all his Oxford posts except the Professorship and moved his family to London where he quickly built up a private musical teaching practice. He would return to Oxford every summer however to take part in concerts and official functions. He took a house in Great Portland Street but in June 1808 moved to no.2 Duchess Street, Marylebone.
