## Description

John Varley (1778-1842) The Old Church, Hackney, London

Watercolour over pencil heightened with touches of bodycolour 27.8 by 37.7 cm., 10 ¾ by 14 ¾ in.

This depicts the sixteenth century church of St Augustine which was demolished in 1798 to make way for a new church on the site dedicated to St John. The large funerary monument to the left survives. Varley was born in a house adjoining Hackney churchyard in 1778. Another version of this watercolour, dated 1830, is in the British Museum (see Lindsay Stainton, British Landscape Watercolours 1600-1860, 1985, no.110, pl.83).
