Signed lower centre A. Nicholl RHA, further inscribed and dated verso, The Jungle pine Ceylon/April 27. 1847-/The jungle pine grows to the height of 14 or 16 feet, it bears fruit exactly/similar to a pine apple, this fruit is considered by the natives to be poisonous
Watercolour heightened with bodycolour and stopping out
31.9 by 45.8 cm., 12 ½ by 18 in.
