Inscribed on part of old mount: From under the Bridge..... Llangollen
Pen and grey ink and watercolour over traces of pencil
32.7 by 45.1 cm., 12 $\frac{3}{4}$ by 17 $\frac{3}{4}$ in.

This originates from Ibbetson's 1792 summer tour of North Wales in the company of Robert Fulke Greville (1751-1824). He was in Llangollen in July and there are a number of recorded Llangollen views.
